You have to type in the following command in Terminal. **NOT** while logged in to Venus.

scp *username*@venus.cs.qc.cuny.edu: ~/*file_path* ~/Desktop

Where username is your login name for the Venus server, and

where file_path is the path to your file

If you created the file and left it in your home directory then you just need to put the file's name.

Ex:

scp aban1234@venus.cs.qc.cuny.edu:~/hello_world.cpp ~/Desktop

If you enter this correctly then you will get a prompt to enter your Venus password.

After you enter your password you will see the file appear on your desktop.
