

How to Transfer a File from Terminal to Machine (for Mac users)

To transfer a file from Terminal on a Mac to your machine you need to use the scp command in Terminal.

You have to type in the following command in Terminal. **NOT** while logged in to Venus.

```
scp username@venus.cs.qc.cuny.edu: ~/file_path ~/Desktop
```

Where **username** is your login name for the Venus server, and

where **file_path** is the path to your file

If you created the file and left it in your home directory then you just need to put the file's name.

Ex:

```
scp aban1234@venus.cs.qc.cuny.edu:~/hello_world.cpp ~/Desktop
```

If you enter this correctly then you will get a prompt to enter your Venus password.

After you enter your password you will see the file appear on your desktop.
