## CS111 lab - Guideline on submitting your programming assignments:

- Due date and cutoff date are strictly followed.
   Assignments are usually due on Thursday.
   Late submission will be accepted until 6 p.m. ET on Friday. Some points will be taken off if it is late.
   Assignments submitted after cutoff date are disregarded.
- 2) Include (comments) name and section on all the programs.// Last Name, First Name// CS111 11A (11D or 22B) Homework 1
- 3) Variables without self-explanatory names should also be commented. As professor Ryba has suggested, use comments sparingly as well-written code in C++ should be largely self-explanatory.
- 4) Compile and run your program on the venus unix server. If you submit a program that cannot be compiled, you will receive very little or no credit.
- 5) Save your final version of the program source code with the name provided for the assignment **(in lowercase only)** inside the **hwSubmission** folder under the home directory in venus.
